Mid-Atlantic Regional Conference at Johns Hopkins

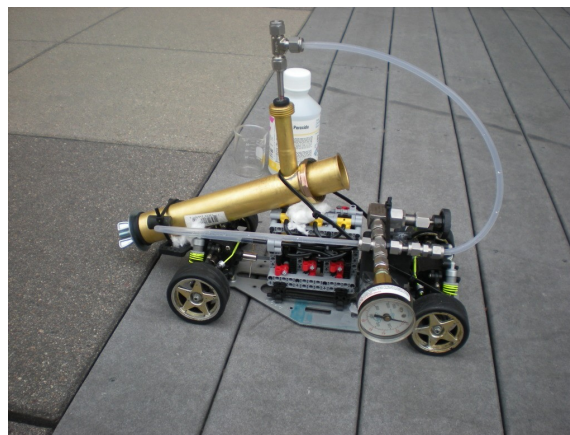
