- FREE 4 Star lunch, fantastic networking opportunity with industry professionals and students from other schools



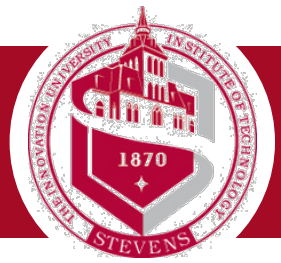

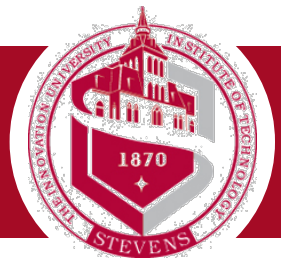


Rocket Project Status

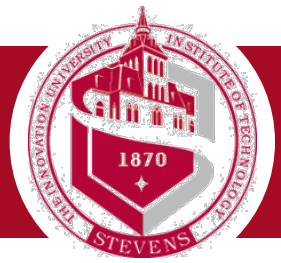




SWE STARTS Participation



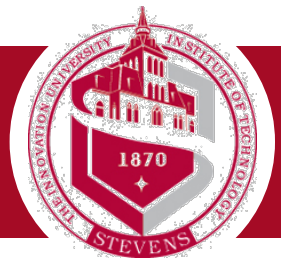
- Co-hosting a table with OXE!

Regional Student Conference



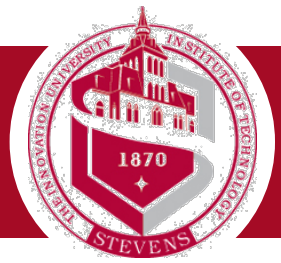
- Where: Princeton

Regional Student Conference



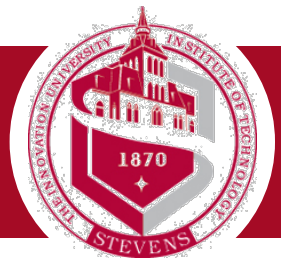
- A google form will be going out for conference attendees.

- Great networking and learning opportunity.



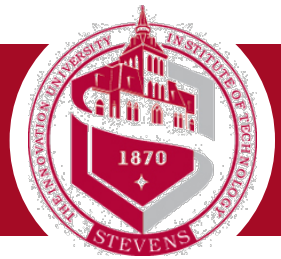
