Minor Board

Chem-E-Car Chair



- a. Oversee participation in and completion of the AIChE Chem-E-Car project
- b. Appoint and remove members of AIChE to the Chem-E-Car committee
- c. Preside over all meetings and competitions of the Chem-E-Car committee.
- d. Call and sanction regular or special meetings of the Chem-E-Car committee
- e. Delegate all duties outlined in the bylaws for the office of Chem-E-Car Chair to voluntary members and officers
- f. Reserve and maintain the use of McLean X004 for club activities
- g. Obtain and store safely materials necessary for completion of the Chem-E-Car project
- h. Perform all duties assigned by the E-Board

- Recommended Credentials
 - Current Chem-E-Car Team member
 - Strong initiative and organizational skills



Publicity Chair



- a. Responsible for AIChE's advertising
 - b. Publicize and promote AIChE's events, meetings, and projects a reasonable time in advance of the relevant dates
 - c. Remove and replace past or irrelevant advertising in a timely fashion
 - d. Delegate all duties outlined in the bylaws for the office of Publicity Chair to voluntary members and officers
 - e. Perform all duties assigned by the E-Board

 - Previous graphic design experience
 - Strong social media presence
