Student Scholarship Awards for Stevens:


- 1. Lee Parker Memorial (Co-founder of Section and Chairperson)

This year we are also offering two "at large" scholarships funded by Mr. Ara Barsamian, President and CEO of Refinery Automation Institute, LLC, and a Director on the North Jersey AIChE Section's Executive Committee. These scholarships will be awarded to the best qualified applicant, regardless of whether they attend NJIT or SIT. These three scholarships are as follows:

The Executive Committee of the North Jersey Section will review the qualifications of the scholarship award nominees, as presented on the Scholarship Application, and via a copy of the nominee's resume or curriculum vitae. This review and final determination of award recipients will be made no later than the February Executive Committee meeting. The scholarship award winners will be notified through their student chapter adviser, and the awards will be presented at a spring 2022 monthly section dinner meeting, date and location to be determined.
