

Introduction

Habitat for Humanity is a non profit organization that helps rebuild struggling neighborhoods or people in need such as veterans.

Stevens Habitat for Humanity works with local organizations in nearby neighborhoods to help rebuild communities



We do 3-4 builds a semester which generally last from 8-5 PM including travel

They are between 30 minutes to 1 hour drive away

We take care of travel costs if no volunteer driver is available

Meet in the morning between 7:30-8:00 am

Get back around 4:00-5:00 PM

Bring money for lunch

How to sign up for Builds

A week before the build Karen will send out a google survey to sign up at exactly 10 PM

Selection for who goes is based on a first come, first serve basis

We bring only 10 people to go on each build so be ready for the sign up survey!

If you were selected you will get a follow up email with further instructions

What to expect from Builds

The Builds are generally located in Passaic, Essex, or Monmouth County

Monmouth is the most frequent place which is generally close to an hour away

You will arrive and professional Habitat for Humanity volunteers will be present and will help instruct you on how you can help

Wear clothes that you are okay with getting dirty

What do you work on

You will help the professional Habitat workers do any task they are doing for that day

They teach you how to do it, help you do it, and let you do it on your own the better you get

They generally remember people who frequently come and we have a good relationship with Monmouth Habitat

I have helped build siding, ramps, stripped doors, roofs, etc.



During Spring Break we have a big trip to another state to help a different community that will be selected at a later date

The trip is one week long

We do fundraisers throughout the year to help lower the cost of the trip

Costs around 300-400 dollars

Previous years have gone to Florida and Tennessee

We will send out applications late this semester
