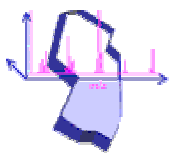

NJ-ACS MSDG Student Travel Awards (2)

Up to two travel grants of \$1,000 apiece are provided by NJ-ACS MSDG to allow a senior undergraduate or graduate student or postdoctoral fellow from a greater New Jersey region university to travel and present a poster or oral presentation at the ASMS Annual Conference.

Completed nomination form along with a copy of the abstract submitted to ASMS should be mailed (or email) to the NJ-ACS MSDG Director of Awards by April 20, 2009.

Preference will be given for work that has not been previously presented or published. A supporting letter from the research director/supervisor should also be sent along with the application. In addition, acceptance of the presentation by ASMS is required for qualification.

The award decision will be made by the Officers of the NJ-ACS MSDG. **The award will be announced at the NJ-ACS MSDG May 2009 meeting with the presentation of a \$1,000 cash award.** Nominations will not be returned.
