# Solution #1: Non-SGA budget

Load-in food	\$50	\$20
Director's gifts	\$40	\$70
Cast Party	\$200	~\$300
Copier	\$400	-
Tickets	\$200	-
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>\$1,290</b>	<b>\$410</b>
Remaining	\$55	



# Solution #2: Strategic spending

- No buffer = no flexibility
- ~\$460 come out of our Non-SGA account to temporarily pay for advance ticket purchases
- We will buy tickets after we start receiving a bulk of T-shirt and Ad money
