- Pre-Requisites:
 - o Required Courses
 - ChemBio curriculum set up for Med School,
 - Other Majors need make schedule adjustments
 - Make sure you take all courses you need before taking MCAT or DAT.
 - o Exams: MCATS or DAT
 - Offered every month now.
 - Must wait 90 days in between taking
 - Online Test, approx \$225/test
 - DAT score is given day of test
 - MCAT 5 week wait, since two essays must be graded
 - Good scores: MCAT-30, DAT-19

o Letters of Recommendation and HPAC interview

- Academic Criteria
- GPA, no one from Stevens has ever gotten in below 3.0. Average UMDNJ Matriculant MCAT Score = 30
- Last 3 years in allopathic medicine, lowest GPA was 3.3
- Health Professionals Advisor Committee (HPAC) letter of recommendation, after an interview with you spring of Junior year.
- Use essay to give out info about you not asked for with grades and test scores.
- o Extra-Curricular Science
 - Research
- o Extra-Curricular Non-Science
 - o Leadership in clubs
- o Volunteering
 - o EMT Great Position
- o Professional
 - o Appearance, manners, modesty, professional behavior.
- Stay Sane
 - Actors, Musicians, Thespians seemed to be favored now by medical schools.
 - What do you do in your free time?
- Make sure to apply early
 - Want to get in for 2011, must apply as early an as soon as June 1st, 2010
 - o Apply to AMCAS, takes 2-6 weeks for processing
 - o Must check background of Honor Board violations
 - o Approx. \$30 per school.
 - o HPAC letters are sent with Secondary applications each another \$75.
- Two types of medicine
 - o Allopathic medicine (MD)
 - Osteopathic medicine- (DO)
 - recognized as full doctors
 - must believe in their differences
 - 1/3 of US doctors are DO, just not big in NYC area.
