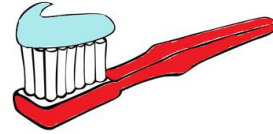


FREE DENTAL SCREENINGS

Rutgers School of Dental Medicine senior students will be taking their board licensing exam on **Saturday March 5th and Sunday March 6th** and are **performing FREE dental screenings now!** This screening includes an exam and x-rays. For your convenience, screenings will be brief and can be scheduled during the day (M-F, 10am-4pm) or in the evening (M-Th, 4-6:30pm).

The screening process and board licensing exam are a fantastic experience for pre-dental students! This unique opportunity provides a behind-the-scenes look at what is widely considered the most important day of dental school. You will also have an insider's look at the Rutgers School of Dental Medicine clinics, meet faculty and current students, learn about diagnosing dental disease, and get a great story to tell in your dental school interview!

If your screening shows that you qualify as a board exam patient and you are able to participate in the exam, *the dental treatment provided that day will be free **and** you will be compensated for your time and participation.* In order to participate, you must be available to be at the Rutgers School of Dental Medicine in Newark for the entire day of Saturday March 5th and/or Sunday March 6th. If you do not qualify for the specific needs of the board licensing exam, we are happy to provide information on becoming a regular patient of the dental school.

What we are looking for:

- ✓ Patients 18 or older
- ✓ Patients with all or most of their teeth
- ✓ Patients with small cavities (Not sure? That's what the screening exam is for!)
- ✓ Patients who are overdue for a cleaning by 1-4 years
- ✓ Patients who have a history of "periodontal disease" and are overdue for a cleaning
