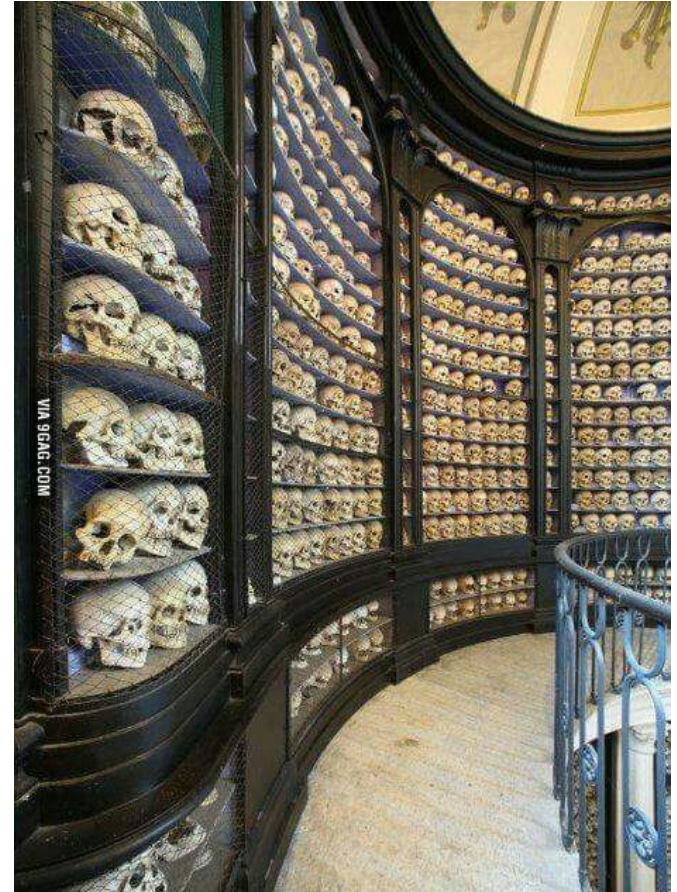
# Mutter Museum
