Coding it Forward is a nonprofit organization creating new opportunities and pathways into social impact and civic technology. Our flagship program is the Civic Digital Fellowship: a paid, 10-week internship for mission-driven software engineering, data science, product management, and design students who want to solve technical challenges at federal agencies. Our partners include the U.S. Census Bureau and National Institutes of Health.

Applicants must be U.S. citizens due to federal hiring regulations, enrolled in an accredited undergraduate or graduate degree program, and graduating no earlier than Dec 2020.
