Coding it Forward is a nonprofit organization creating new opportunities and pathways into social impact and civic technology. The Civic Innovation Corps is a 10-week internship connecting mission-driven software engineers, data scientists, product managers, and designers to civic tech opportunities in city and state governments from coast to coast.

Applicants must be authorized to work in the United States; enrolled in a two- or four-year institution, bootcamp, or certificate program; and graduating no earlier than Dec 2020.

We're looking for software engineers, data scientists, designers, and product managers who want to improve the products and services that residents interact with daily—from data analysis and visualization of economic recovery datasets in Miami to COVID-19 evictions analysis in Los Angeles.

Corps members will have the opportunity to learn and grow as a member of a tight-knit community of passionate technologists and participate in Corps-specific programming specially designed for state and local contexts.

## **BE PAID FOR YOUR WORK.**

Our team seeks to make the Civic Innovation Corps as accessible and equitable as possible—which is why every Corps member will receive a stipend. Undergraduates, bootcamp, or certificate program grads will receive \$6,000, while graduate students will receive \$7,000.

# CORONAVIRUS UPDATE
